This recital concentrates on the development of classical piano music. This weighty program includes works by Beethoven, Brahms, and de Falla.

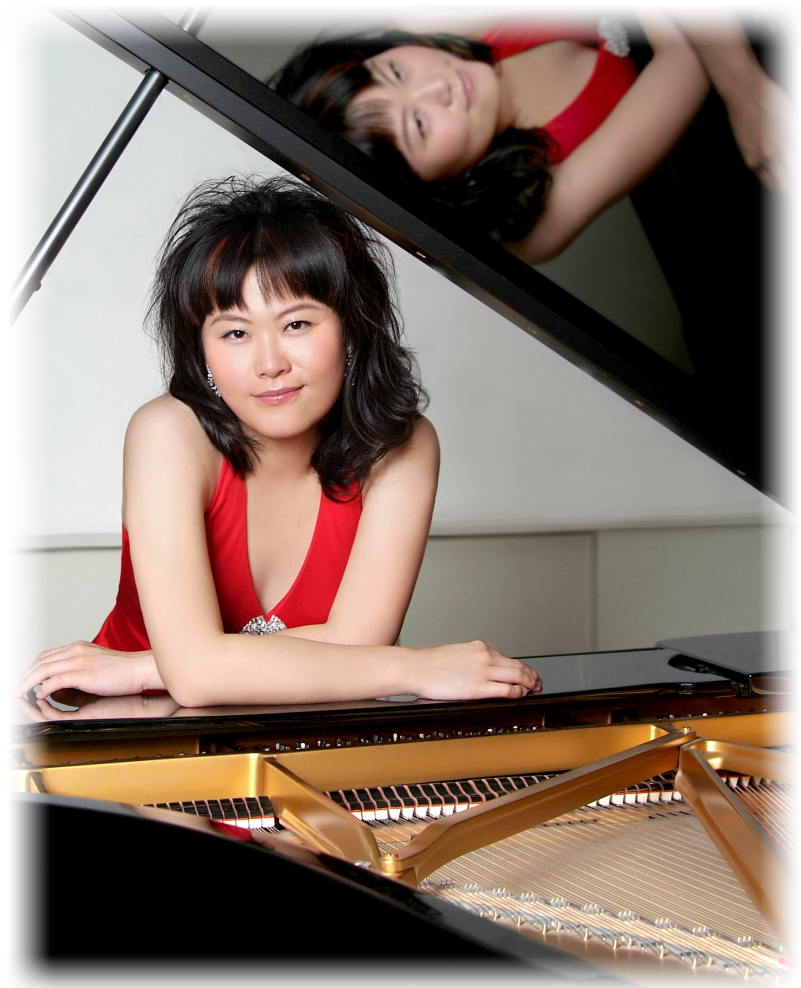
### *Young People Concert*
